Eligibility Criteria for Admission under Regulation R-2021

1. First-Year Entry (First Semester) – B.E. / B.Tech.

To be eligible for admission into the eight-semester B.E./B.Tech. programs under Regulation R-2021:

- You must have passed the **10+2 Higher Secondary Examination (Academic Stream)** as prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu (or its equivalent approved by Anna University).
- The required subjects are **Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry** as part of Part-III of the Higher Secondary curriculum.
- Alternatively, having passed a **Vocational stream (groups in Engineering/Technology)** in the HSC (10+2) is also acceptable.

2. Lateral Entry (Into Third Semester)

For candidates seeking lateral entry into the third semester:

- A Diploma in Engineering/Technology from the Tamil Nadu State Board of Technical Education (or equivalent recognized) makes you eligible.
- Alternatively, a Bachelor's degree in Science (B.Sc.) via the 10+2+3 route, with Mathematics as a subject at the B.Sc. level, also qualifies.
- Lateral entry students must additionally complete two more engineering subjects in the third and fourth semesters as per the university's requirements.

Entry Type	Qualification Required
First-Year (1st Semester)	10+2 Academic (or equivalent) with Mathematics, Physics & Chemistry (or vocational HSC)
Lateral Entry (3rd Semester)	Engineering Diploma or B.Sc. (10+2+3) with Mathematics at B.Sc. level



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Notes on Additional Admission Policies (not necessarily part of R-2021)

- **Minimum Marks:** For admissions in 2021, general category candidates required at least **45% aggregate** in Mathematics, Physics & Chemistry; for SC/ST, it was **40%**.
- **Special Categories (NRI/CIWGC/FN):** Candidates must have passed 10+2 (or equivalent) and should typically have an average of **50% in Mathematics, Physics & Chemistry**; this also involves documentation and a **Provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC)** from Anna University.
- **Selection Process:** Admission to B.E. / B.Tech. is typically via **Tamil Nadu Engineering Admissions (TNEA)** counseling, based on 10+2 marks—not via an entrance exam.

3. PG Eligibility Criteria under Regulation R-2021

While Anna University's official **Regulation R-2021** primarily addresses UG programs, several reputable sources outline PG eligibility standards consistent with this regulation's framework:

General Eligibility for PG (M.E)

- A **B.E. / B.Tech.** degree in the relevant discipline with at least **50% aggregate marks (45% for SC/ST/PH)** from a recognized university.
- A **Diploma + AMIE** (Associate Member of Institution of Engineers), coupled with **two years of work experience**, can be considered equivalent.
- **Distance or weekend mode degrees are not eligible.**
- **Sponsored candidates** (from government or aided institutions) must have **five or more years of relevant work experience** *and* a valid **TANCET** score.



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Admission Tests: TANCET and GATE

- PG admissions typically follow based on **TANCET** (Tamil Nadu Common Entrance Test) scores, which are mandatory unless the candidate holds a valid **GATE** score in a relevant discipline.
- GATE-qualified candidates are **exempted from taking TANCET**.
- Valid GATE scores from Engineering Science (XE) or Life Sciences (XL) may also be considered, sometimes in combination with TANCET scores.
- **TANCET eligibility** outlines that candidates must be graduates (even those in their final year), with exceptions made for those with relevant GATE scores.

CedSo & JMF SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES

The following (CedSo & JMF) - CedSo & JMF Scholarships & bursaries are offered to CCET College of Engineering and technology students through following categories:

- JACOB MARY FOUNDATION Academic Merit Scholarships
- JACOB MARY FOUNDATION Extra-curricular Scholarship.
- JACOB MARY FOUNDATION Sports Scholarships (recognized sports ONLY):
- JACOB MARY FOUNDATION Pastors & Ministry Worker's Scholarships.
- CEASCo STAFF, SIBLINGS & ALUMNI BURSARY

ACADEMIC MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

- All students with greater than 70% overall percentage in their 12th Board Exam for CCET/RJMC or 10th for CPT are automatically eligible for a 20% tuition fee scholarship (i.e they pay 80% of their annual tuition fees).
- All students with greater than 90% overall percentage in their 12th Board Exam for CCET/RJMC or 10th for CPT are automatically eligible for a 50% scholarship (i.e they pay 50% of their annual tuition fees).

EXTRA-CURRICULAR SCHOLARSHIP

- All students with special abilities or qualifications or achievements within the past 2 years, at a State Level (e.g. research study or quiz or exceptional musical talent) WITH PROOF / CERTIFICATES are eligible to apply for a special extra-curricular scholarship.

SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP

- All students with a Zonal (Gold Only) or District or Divisional level (Gold, Silver or Bronze) medal & certificate in any recognized sport* are automatically eligible for a 20, 10, 10% scholarship respectively (i.e. they pay 80 or 90% of their annual tuition fees).
- All students with a State level Gold, Silver or Bronze medal & certificate in any recognized sport* are automatically eligible for a 30, 20, 10% scholarship respectively (i.e. they pay 70 or 80% of their annual tuition fees).
- All students with a National level Gold, Silver or Bronze medal in any recognized

sport* are automatically eligible for a 60, 40, 20% scholarship respectively (i.e. they pay 40 or 60 or 80% of their annual tuition fees).

PASTORS & MINISTRY WORKER'S SCHOLARSHIPS

- Full-time Evangelists & Pastor's OWN (biological) children are eligible for a 50% CEASCo Society scholarship on their tuition fees. However, Pastor's recommendation students are only eligible for 20% scholarship.
- Applies across all the years of the course.
- As the total value of this scholarship is 1 to 1.5 lakhs, to qualify the Pastor has to get a letter & proof of position from the head of the church (usually the bishop), mentioning his parish or congregation details. Proof of an "evangelist" requires at least letters of support from TWO ordained Pastors, confirming their work and region with proof of the same.

CEASCo STAFF, SIBLINGS & ALUMNI BURSARY

- All CEASCo staff are eligible for a bursary price from the funds of the society for their OWN (biological) children. Staff from the sister institution are eligible for a 30% staff bursary (they pay 70% of tuition fees), and staff from other CEASCo institutions are eligible for a 20% staff bursary (they pay 80% of tuition fees). The staff member must have completed 2 years continuous service in a CEASCo Institution before the date of admission to the course; provided the staff remains a faculty member in a CEASCo institution.

SIBLING BURSARY

- Sibling Bursaries are available at 10% reduction in Tuition fee for a biological (own) brother or sister.

ALUMNI BURSARY

- Alumni of any of the 6 institutions are automatically eligible for a CEASCo Alumni Bursary of 10% reduction in tuition fee on tuition fees. e.g. 10% bursary reduction, after a CEASCo branch school education in a CCET admission. 10% Alumni Bursary, means a Rs.5000 reduction approx.
