OVERVIEW

Christian College of Engineering and Technology (CCET), Oddanchatram was founded by Dr. Jacob Cherian, M.B.B.S., FRCS, who is also a member of The Christian Fellowship Hospital (CFH). It is managed by the Christian Education Health and Development Society. The first batch commenced in 2001. CCET is an esteemed institution located in the serene backdrop of the Kodaikanal hills, in Oddanchatram, Dindigul District, Tamil Nadu. Established in 2001, CCET is approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), affiliated with Anna University, Chennai, accredited by NAAC with a B++ grade (2.83 CGPA) and recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956.

At the time of its inception in 2001, the college offered three courses, namely B.E. (Electronics and Communication Engineering), B.E. (Computer Science and Engineering), and B.Tech. (Information Technology). In 2005, B.E. (Electrical and Electronics Engineering) was introduced, followed by B.E. (Mechanical Engineering) and B.E. (Civil Engineering) in 2009. In 2023, B.Tech. (Artificial Intelligence and Data Science) and B.Tech. (Agricultural Engineering) were started. In 2024, B.E. CSE (Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning) was introduced. In 2011, a PG course named M.E. (Applied Electronics) was launched. Along the way, in 2013, M.E. courses in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) and Power Electronics and Drives (PED) were started, and in 2014, M.E. (Manufacturing Engineering) and M.E. (Construction Engineering and Management) were introduced. In 2018, a full-time Ph.D. research programme in Mechanical Engineering was established. The college has witnessed steady growth in student intake and overall academic performance since its inception.

CCET is a private engineering college currently offering 9 undergraduate and 5 postgraduate programmes across various engineering disciplines, along with a research Programme. The institution follows Anna University's regulations, syllabus, and examination system, with degrees awarded directly by the university. Christian College of Engineering and Technology adheres strictly to the university's academic and research guidelines. Various cells and committees are established to support student welfare and inculcate innovative and research ideas, while the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) monitors all academic and

administrative activities. The institution has well established laboratories, dedicated and experienced faculty members to enhance teaching-learning process. A modernized Central library with 27,339 books, sufficient print and e-journals, OPAC system for searching books, Wi-Fi connectivity, spacious reading area, access to digital resources provides a conducive learning environment to the students and faculty for knowledge upgradation. The institution provides adequate and accessible drinking water facilities to ensure the health, safety, comfort, and well-being of students, faculty members, and staff.

CCET Placement Cell regularly organizes various activities to improve students' employability skills and personality development. It maintains regular interaction with industries and prospective employers through Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs). Industry representatives are invited to conduct pre-placement talks, technical sessions, recruitment drives, workshops, expert lectures, and skill-development programmes.

The Alumni Association serves as a strong and enduring bridge between the institution and its alumni. It provides a platform for alumni to support the academic and professional development of current students through mentorship, knowledge sharing, internships, career guidance, and scholarships.

Additionally, the NSS unit plays a vital role in shaping students into responsible citizens through community service, awareness campaigns, rural outreach programs, and capacity-building initiatives, fostering civic responsibility and leadership.

Apart from academics, CCET provides facilities for various indoor and outdoor games and sports, such as Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Badminton, Table Tennis, Chess, Carrom, Athletics, Silambam, Karate, Other recreational and fitness activities. Gymnasium with required equipments also help our students to maintain a good physical and mental health. Seminar halls with LCD projectors and white screens provide opportunities for students and faculty members to interact with academicians, industry professionals, researchers, entrepreneurs, and other experts.
