

FEE REFUND POLICY 2026–27

In Compliance with UGC (Redressal of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2023

Christian College of Engineering and Technology considers the request for cancellation of admission/withdrawal from the programme, if such request is made in accordance with the applicable guidelines of the University Grants Commission (UGC) and other competent statutory authorities.

If a student chooses to withdraw from the programme in which he/she is enrolled, the refund of the fees paid shall be made as per the following UGC guidelines:

- a) The College shall provide refund of fees for cancellation of admission/withdrawal in accordance with the UGC Fee Refund Policy applicable to the respective academic year.
- b) For admission schedules extending beyond the prescribed admission period, the provisions contained in the applicable UGC notification/guidelines on refund of fees and non-retention of original certificates shall be followed.

Category	Percentage of Fee Refundable	Point of Time when Notice of Withdrawal of Admission is Received
1	100%	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission
2	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission
3	80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission
4	50%	More than 15 days but up to 30 days after the formally notified last date of admission
5	00% (Nil)	More than 30 days after the formally notified last date of admission

The above refund structure shall be subject to the latest UGC notifications/guidelines and the regulations of AICTE, Anna University, Government of Tamil Nadu and other competent authorities, wherever applicable.

The date of receipt of the duly submitted written request for withdrawal/cancellation of admission by the College shall be considered for determining the applicable refund category.

The College shall process eligible refunds after verification of the student's records and completion of the prescribed formalities. Refundable caution money/security deposits, wherever applicable, shall be dealt with as per the applicable rules.

In case of any amendment or revised notification issued by the UGC or any other competent statutory authority, the latest applicable statutory provision shall prevail.
