

RESERVATION ROSTER

Reservation Policy and Five-Year Implementation Statement

Christian College of Engineering and Technology follows the applicable Government of Tamil Nadu norms and guidelines relating to communal reservation in admissions. The reservation roster is maintained to ensure transparency, equitable representation and compliance with the prescribed reservation policy.

As per the applicable reservation norms, the communal reservation categories include Open Competition (OC), Backward Class (BC), Backward Class Muslim (BCM), Most Backward Class and Denotified Communities (MBC/DNC), Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Caste Arunthathiyars (SCA), and Scheduled Tribes (ST). The prescribed reservation percentages are 31% for Open Competition, 26.5% for BC, 3.5% for BCM, 20% for MBC/DNC, 15% for SC, 3% for SCA and 1% for ST.

The reservation roster of the Institution has been reviewed for the five academic years from 2021–2022 to 2025–2026. The category-wise details are maintained based on the student admission records of the respective academic years.

Category-wise Five-Year Overview

The five-year roster indicates representation across all the prescribed reservation categories. During the period under review, the institution admitted students belonging to BC, BCM, MBC/DNC, SC, SCA, ST and Open Competition categories.

The total number of students covered in the roster increased from 153 in 2021–2022 to 257 in 2025–2026, reflecting the variation in student admissions across the five academic years.

The institution maintains the reservation roster and supporting admission records for transparency and institutional compliance. The category-wise data presented above is based on the reservation roster maintained for the respective academic years.
